The regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Angola, Indiana was called to order at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall, 210 North Public Square, with Mayor David B. Martin presiding. Council Members Randy Coffey, David A. Olson, Jennifer L. Sharkey, and Jerold D. McDermid answered roll. Council Member Charles P. Dowe was absent. Clerk-Treasurer Ryan P. Herbert recorded the minutes.

Among those present were City Attorney Kim Shoup, Economic Development and Planning Director Retha Hicks, Street Commissioner Chad Ritter, Human Resources Director Sue Essman, Deputy Clerk Stephanie Dean and Police Patrol Office Allie Curdes.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Council Member Coffey moved to approve the May 4, 2026 minutes. Council Member Sharkey seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Ordinance No. 1799-2026, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANGOLA MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 10 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, CHAPTER 10.15 TRAFFIC, SECTION 10.15.160, PROHIBITED TURNS, was read by title and presented to Council on second reading. Council Member Olson moved to approve. Council Member Sharkey seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

Ordinance No. 1800-2026, AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A DESIGNATED OUTDOOR REFRESHMENT AREA (DORA), was read by title and presented to Council on second reading. Council Member McDermid moved to approve. Council Member Coffey seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

NEW BUSINESS

Ordinance No. 1801-2026. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF ANGOLA, INDIANA (SR 827 North of Eastland Crossing Section I), was read by title and presented to Council for first reading. Council Member Olson moved to approve. Council Member Sharkey seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

Alexander Atwood of 200 W Pleasant Street addressed Council regarding city yard waste pickup policy.

Council Member Sharkey moved to approve Change Order No. 2 for Pokagon Utility Project Division 3 (Angola Wastewater Improvements). Council Member McDermid seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

Council Member Olson moved to terminate abatement Ventra LLC located at 3000 Woodhull Drive. Resolution No. 2016-697, ten years. Council Member Coffey seconded the motion. Discussion followed. The motion carried 4-0.

Clerk-Treasurer's Depository Statement and Cash Reconciliation for the month ending April 2026 was presented for Council information.

DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

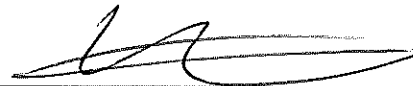
Economic Development and Planning Director Hicks reported that new downtown sculptures would be installed on June 5th.
